# RTFNZ/GRANT THORNTON TRANSPORT COST INDEX QUARTER ENDING MARCH 2020 (PUBLISHED 24 JUNE 2020)

Please find attached the Grant Thornton (GT) index for the quarter ending March 2020, plus continuation of the forecast index to June 2020.

Grant Thornton continues to provide an enhanced index (refer to pages 1 to 3) by including a year-by-year rolling comparison in table form, line graph and bar graph representations.

Also provided is the relevant forecourt diesel prices (less GST) in table form (page 3) that support the forecast (provisional) quarterly index changes to June 2020, shown on page 2.

The diesel cost table is accompanied by its own graphical presentation of fuel price changes over the past nine months. However, we stress that the fuel data from MBIE that supports the June index is provisional.

As pointed out in previous quarterly cover notes, MBIE has changed its fuel reporting methodology used for monitoring weekly fuel prices.

Due to the delay in MBIE fuel price reporting, a regression calculation has been used to complete the pricing for the provisional or forecasted quarter.

To support the provisional index GT has also brought forward the planned July 2020 Road User Charges (RUC) increase.

The cost index table on page 1 includes a number of important notes for users of the index. Please read these notes.

Fuel pricing continues to be volatile and the worldwide reduction in the demand for automotive diesel fuel through the Covid-19 period has seen forecourt costs fall dramatically. This in turn, has had a significant impact on the index. The unusually large reduction in the index has been checked and rechecked and then recalculated by Grant Thornton data analysts from first principles to ensure it is correct.

We would point out the low diesel prices may be a short-lived phenomenon as we are seeing fuel prices in USA beginning to rise incrementally. The fuel price is expected to rise in New Zealand once the international oversupply issues are resolved.

All other costs have risen incrementally with wages and R&M showing an upswing with overheads and insurance drifting upwards.

It is worth noting the index is **not** a pricing index, it is a cost index and using this exclusively to support remuneration payments without any recognition of margins has the potential to lead to financial stress for contractors.

RTF expected to be in a position to reset the index base this quarter given the operator cost comparison analysis by University of Waikato report was completed earlier this year. Instead of resetting the base in the same quarter as introducing the increase in RUC, and thereby avoiding the potential for interpretational complications, we have elected to hold off the base index resetting until the September publishing period. The resetting process will include tables that enable users to move data sets between different bases.

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



No account has been taken of the effects of GST, which must be accounted for separately. All information is based on quarterly average prices and is obtained from either Statistics New Zealand or MBIE. MBIE has amended their methodology to account for price differences between Auckland and the rest of the country as a result of the Auckland Regional Fuel Tax. The adjustment was applied from 1 July 2018 and accordingly, historical publications do not reflect on the changes that were made.

An increase in the RUC rate will come into effect from 1 July 2020. Based on advice from the Ministry of Transport, the expected average RUC rate increase is approximately 5.3%. To assist users of the publication to estimate the impact of this, we have early adopted the change to start from the June 2020 Quarter. This is represented by the June forecast column.








